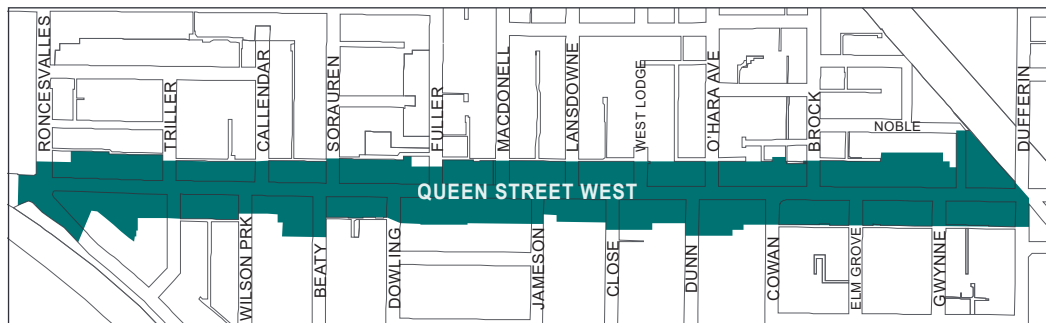
# ABOUT YOUR BIA

## PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING

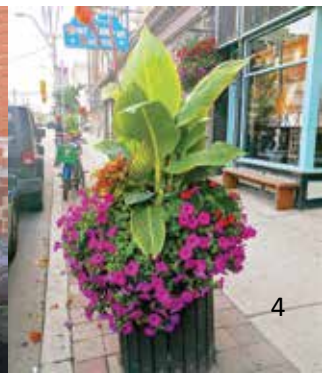
