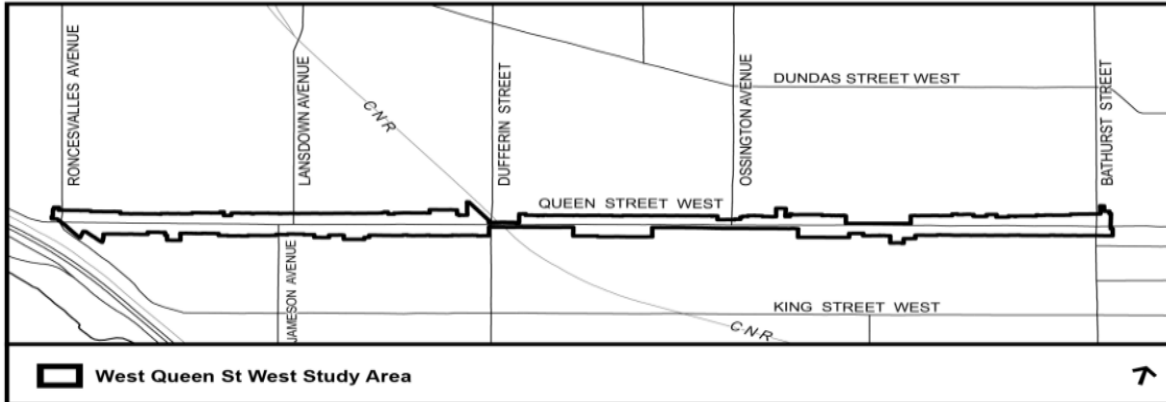


WEST QUEEN WEST HERITAGE CONSERVATION DISTRICT STUDY
